<p>LCE-07-2016-2017 Under call H2020-LCE-2016-2017, in topic LCE-07-2016-2017, sub-challenge h) for 2016, could you explain the scale of the ">1MW medium and large-scale industrial CHP"?</p>	<p>This refers to the total used energy output (thermal and electrical), not to the energy content of the fuel input.</p>
<p>LCE-15-2016: Under call H2020-LCE-2016-2017, topic LCE-15-2016, who will select the experts in charge of assessing the deliverables and giving advice for the go/no decision?</p>	<p>The independent experts for the committee in charge of this aspect will be selected by the Commission.</p>
<p>LCE-15-2016: Does the 'date of application' in topic LCE-15-2016 under call H2020-LCE-2016-2017 refer to the application of the technology?</p>	<p>No, this refers to the date of submission of your proposal.</p>
<p>LCE-24-2016: For the topic LCE-24-2016 under call H2020-LCE-2016-2017, where can I find the list of South Korean projects endorsed for this twinning activity?</p>	<p>The list of projects endorsed by the South Korean Ministry of Science, ICT and Future Planning (MSIP) is now available in the 'Topic conditions and documents' (8. <p>LCE-23-2016: The topic LCE-23-2016 under call H2020-LCE-2016-2017 requires a coordination with a Mexican project, should Mexican entities be included in the consortium (Part A of the proposal)?</p>	<p>No, the details of the coordinated Mexican proposal to be submitted to the Mexican authorities should be included in the proposal description (Part B). Please be aware that proposals which do not include coordination with a Mexican project will be considered ineligible.</p>
<p>LCE-23-2016: For the topic LCE-23-2016 under call H2020-LCE-2016-2017, who is the funding organisation for the coordinated Mexican call for proposals?</p>	<p>The Mexican funding organisations for topic LCE-23-2016 are SENER (México Federal Government, Ministry of Energy) and CONACYT (National Council for Science and Technology) through the Sectorial Fund "CONACYT-SENER-Sustentabilidad Energética".
